1 ソフトウェアの説明

このソフトウェアは、PC でヒューマンマシンインタフェース(HMI)のユーザーアプリケーションを開発するための統合開発環境を提供します。開発した HMI ユーザーアプリケーションは、ランタイムソフトウェアによって複数のハードウェアで動作します。

ランタイムのインストールまたはアンインストールは、管理者権限で実行してください。

プロジェクトファイルを転送する場合、転送前にランタイムを管理者権限で起動してください。

4 安全なアプリケーションのために

このセクションでは、アプリケーションを安全に設定するためのポイントについて説明します。

4.1 サイバーセキュリティベストプラクティス

4.2 不正アクセス防止のための安全なネットワークを構築する

- イーサネット通信に基づいていない転送オプションを選択します。(例: USB ケーブルまたはファイルシステム)

4.3.1 SP5000 シリーズオープンボックス (Windows 10 IoT Enterprise モデル)、IPC シリーズ、PC/AT を使用する場合

- ランタイムは信頼のできるパソコンでのみ使用してください。
- プロジェクトファイルの転送、またはその他の管理者権限が必要な操作を実行する場合を除き、管理者権限をもつアカウントで **Windows** にログインしないでください。
- **Windows** のセキュリティー機能を使用してください (パスワードの設定、自動ログアウト機能の使用など)。
- プロジェクトの管理者アカウントに安全なパスワードとセキュリティーを設定してください。

8 修正済み制限事項

8.1 作画時の修正済み制限事項

8.1.1 画面編集ソフトウェア

- プロジェクトファイルのエラーを修正したにも関わらず、エラーが表示され続ける問題を改修しました。

-
- プロジェクトで使用している接続機器の台数が上限に達していないにもかかわらず、画面編集ソフトウェア上で"**Reached maximum number of *** equipment.**"のエラーが発生する問題を改修しました。
 - 画面編集ソフトウェアの **CSV** ファイルのインポートに関する問題を改修しました。
 - プロジェクトファイルの保存時に、プロジェクトファイルが破損する問題を改修しました。
 - 多くの画面/コンテンツを表示するために画面編集ソフトウェアが使用するメモリが大きくなる問題を改善しました。
 - 画面編集ソフトウェアが特定の言語設定の場合に、表示器またはシミュレーションで小数値が表示されない問題を改修しました。
 - 画面編集ソフトウェアで複数のオブジェクトをドラッグで選択した場合に、正しく動作しない問題を改修しました。

8.1.2 画面 / コンテンツ

- 画面編集ソフトウェアで[グリッドの表示]を有効にし、スクロールキャンバスやズームキャンバスなどの幅・高さが変更可能なレイアウトオブジェクトの大きさを広げた場合に、グリッドが正しく表示されない問題を改修しました。
- 画面編集ソフトウェアで、ナビゲーション機能で使用されるナビゲーションスイッチのプロパティが不正にバインドできる問題を改修しました。
- 画面またはコンテンツを画面編集ソフトウェアバージョン **3.3** からバージョン **3.2**、**3.2 Service Pack 1**、**3.2 Service Pack 2** にコピーした場合に、予期しない動作が発生する場がある問題を改修しました。

8.1.3 部品 / 図形

- [Ctrl]キーとマウスを使用して部品や図形をコピーした場合、意図せず同じ位置に部品や図形が複製される問題を改修しました。
- オブジェクトのタッチ操作（プロパティウィンドウの[機能]タブ→[タッチ]タブ）で文字列を設定する場合、[ソース]に定数で大きな数値を設定すると設定先に正しい文字列が設定されない問題を改修しました。

8.1.4 スクリプト

- [データロギング]の値ブロックに[TriggerVariable]プロパティが不正に表示される問題を改修しました。
- スクリプトで使用されている変数を削除した後、別の変数を削除された変数と同じ名前に変更しても、エラーと変数ブロック内の **Undefined** が解決されない問題を改修しました。
- スクリプトで[機器]値ブロックの設定値が空白のままの場合、画面編集ソフトウェアが突然終了する問題を改修しました。

- 変数がブロックモードのスクリプトで使用されていないにもかかわらず、画面編集ソフトウェアで変数のエラーが表示される問題を改修しました。

- 以下の文字を含む文字列をリテラルとして使用すると、スクリプト編集画面のテキストモードで構文エラーが表示される問題を改修しました。

➤ /u

➤ /x

- 変数名に以下の言語の文字が含まれる場合、スクリプト編集画面のテキストモードで変数名を入力しても入力補助機能が動作しない問題を改修しました。

➤ 日本語

➤ 韓国語

➤ 中国語

- スクリプト編集画面のテキストモードで構造体の配列変数に関連付けたアラームプロパティ（例えば **Var1.WORD1.HiHi.Message**）を使用している場合、変数のアラームの種類を例えば **HiHi** から **LoLo** に変更してもスクリプト内のアラームプロパティが更新されない問題を改修しました。

- テキストモードのスクリプトで下表のキーワードに一致する名前の変数を使用する場合は、接頭辞である"\$Global"を付けてください。例:'\$Global.with'

- スクリプト編集画面のテキストモードで **IME** を使用する場合、IME での入力が正しく動作しない問題を改修しました。

- スクリプト編集画面のテキストモードで置換を連続して実行すると、正しく置換が行われない問題を改修しました。

- 代入式(=)で**\$Math.E()**または**\$Math.Random()**を使用したスクリプトが動作しない問題を改修しました。

- スクリプトで使用されている[表示器]値ブロックのプロパティ名が不完全な場合に、そのまま転送できる問題を改修しました。不完全な設定に対してエラーが表示され、転送が中断されます。

- 画面編集ソフトウェアで配列を含むスクリプトの要素に対して貼り付け/元に戻す/やり直すの操作を行った場合、ランタイムでスクリプトが正しく動作しない問題を改修しました。

8.1.5 アラーム

- 同じ変数のアラームの値に、整数部分が同じ値の異なる実数値を使用できない問題を改修しました。
- アラームに設定されている変数が不正な場合でも、そのまま転送できる問題を改修しました。不正な変数に対してエラーが表示され、転送が中断されます。

8.1.6 ロギング

- エクスポートしたロギングデータの日付と時刻のフォーマットが設定できない問題を改修しました。
- ロギンググループプロパティの[インターロック]プロパティが ON になっても、表示器がロギングデータの収集を継続する問題を改修しました。

8.1.7 変数

- デバイスアドレス入力画面の操作性を改善しました。
- DATE_AND_TIME 型の変数に、表示器の DateAndTime ソースプロパティを代入すると警告が表示される問題を改修しました。
- デバイスアドレスと関連付けた外部変数の[入力範囲]、[最小]、および[最大]の設定が、プロジェクトファイルを開いた場合に初期化される問題を改修しました。
- 配列の編集画面で、検索機能で配列を絞り込んでいる状態で次元の設定値を変更すると、正常に変更されない問題を改修しました。
- 配列要素内の構造体を編集すると画面編集ソフトウェアが突然終了する問題を改修しました。
- シンボルファイルからインポートした配列変数の[次元]の設定が変更できた問題を改修しました。[次元]の設定は変更できません。
- 変数のデータタイプを変更すると、変数とデバイスアドレスのデータタイプが一致していないにも関わらず、画面編集ソフトウェアでエラーが表示されない問題を改修しました。
- インポートする CSV ファイルとインポート先のプロジェクトに同じ名前のフォルダーが存在した場合に、そのフォルダを異なるフォルダと認識してフォルダー数の上限に関するエラーを表示していた問題を改修しました。
- 画面編集ソフトウェアで構造体の子要素の名前を変更すると、異なる構造体で同じ名前の子要素も名前が変更される問題を改修しました。
- デバイスアドレスに関連付けした外部変数をインポートしても、[データ共有]プロパティが変更されない問題を改修しました。
- 変数セレクトダイアログボックス内の検索機能で、構造体内部の変数が正しく検索できない問題を改修しました。

-
- 構造体配列または配列の要素に変数にバインドした場合、ランタイムで正しく値を表示できない問題を改修しました。
 - 画面編集ソフトウェアで、マイナス値、またはゼロ以外の要素番号から始まる配列 (例: **Array1[-1..1]**、**Array2[4..6]**) を含む古いバージョンのプロジェクトを開いて転送した場合、ランタイムで正しく動作しない問題を改修しました。

8.1.7.1 シンボルリンク

- 2 つ以上のシンボルリンクを使用すると、表示器が正しく動作しない問題を改修しました。
- 画面編集ソフトウェアで、シンボルリンク機能でインポートした変数の[保持]プロパティが設定できる状態になっていた問題を改修しました。
- シンボルリンク機能でシンボルファイルをインポート中に、エラーが正しく表示されない問題を改修しました。

8.1.8 シミュレーション

- プロパティウィンドウで小数点にカンマを使用した値を設定すると、シミュレーションが起動しない問題を改修しました。
- 一部のプロパティで小数点の値を使用した場合に、シミュレーションが突然終了する問題を改修しました。

8.1.9 ドライバー

- 以下のドライバーで、接続機器のプロパティ画面から[シリーズ]を変更した場合に表示されるエラーメッセージの内容を改善しました。
 - Siemens AG - SIMATIC S7 MPI 直結
 - Siemens AG - SIMATIC S7 イーサネット
- 以下のドライバーで、不正なユニット ID を設定したプロジェクトが転送できていた問題を改修しました。

8.1.10 外部ストレージ

- アラーム、ロギング、操作ログの[保存先]プロパティに外部ストレージを選択したプロジェクトを、外部ストレージが接続されていない表示器に転送できていた問題を改修しました。

8.2 転送時の修正済み制限事項

- ファイルサイズの上限值を超えたプロジェクトファイルを転送しようとした場合に、画面編集ソフトウェアがエラーを表示しない問題を改修しました。
- GP-Pro EX のプロジェクトファイルが動作している表示器に、[イーサネット設定の転送]が有効になっているプロジェクトファイルを **BLUE** から転送をする場合、転送が正常に終了した場合も画面編集ソフトウェア上で転送エラーが表示された問題を改修しました。

8.3 表示器使用時の修正済み制限事項

8.3.1 画面 / コンテンツ

- 画面編集ソフトウェアの[Target01]プロパティウィンドウで、イーサネット設定が無効のまま[イーサネット設定の転送]チェックボックスのチェックを外すと、[初期画面 ID]プロパティが設定どおりに動作しない問題を改修しました。

8.3.2 部品 / 図形

- 以下の部品で[影]プロパティを使用すると、Web Viewer クライアントが正しく表示されない問題を改修しました。
 - ランプ
 - マルチステートランプ
 - 切り替えスイッチ
 - チェックボックス
 - ラジオボタン

8.3.2.1 文字列表示器

- 文字列表示器に言語テーブルの文字列を出力する範囲コンバーターを設定した変数をバインドすると設定した文字列が表示されずに ID が表示される問題を改修しました。

8.3.2.2 トレンドグラフ

- トレンドグラフで過去データを表示した場合、最新のデータが表示される問題を改修しました。
- トレンドグラフで過去データを表示する際、表示がちらつく問題を改修しました。

8.3.2.3 画像表示器

- 画像表示器の幅をオブジェクトを選択した時に表示されるコントロールアイコン（矢印や拡大、縮小）の幅よりも小さくすると、画像表示器の範囲外にも関わらずタッチできない問題を改修しました。

8.3.3 スクリプト

- スクリプトで、変数の **Quality** プロパティを使用した場合に正しく動作しない問題を改修しました。

8.3.4 トリガー / オペレーション

- `Var1[Var2.Value].Value` のような間接アドレスを指定した変数を[デバッグ表示]オペレーションで使用した場合に、正しく表示されない問題を改修しました。

8.3.5 アラーム

- アラームメッセージで[言語文字列 ID]を関連付けると、アラーム表示器部品のフィルタ機能が正常に動作しない問題を改修しました。

8.3.6 ロギング

- SQL の予約語が、ロギンググループ名として使用できない問題を改修しました。
- ロギンググループの下記設定、エクスポート実行時に表示している画面の構成、および使用している表示器の組み合わせによって、ロギングデータのエクスポートに時間がかかっていた問題を改善しました。
 - 最大レコード数
 - 登録している変数の数
 - エクスポート先のデータストレージ

8.3.7 レシピ

- ランタイムで複数のレシピファミリーまたは複数のグループを設定している場合、ランタイムでレシピデータを編集すると、意図しない箇所のレシピデータが変更される問題を改修しました。

8.3.8 セキュリティ

- ユーザー名やパスワードの入力に失敗してアラーム表示器にエラーメッセージが表示された場合、正しくログインできた後もエラーメッセージが表示される問題を改修しました。

8.3.9 インポート

 - ▶ オブジェクトに'Animation.RotationAngle'および'Animation.Rotation Center(X)/(Y)'が設定されており、かつ幅や高さに変数などが関連付けられている。

8.3.11 OPC UA サーバー

- 構造体や配列変数の Node ID で、構造体や配列変数の名前が重複していた問題を改修しました。

8.3.12 ドライバー

- Schneider Electric の Modbus TCP マスタードライバーで BOOL 型の Unlocated 変数を使用している場合、ランタイムが予期しない領域に対して読み込みを行い、その結果予期しない動作が発生する問題を改修しました。
- 三菱電機株式会社の FX シリーズ CPU 直結ドライバーで FX3UCCPU を使用している場合、ランタイムが正しく通信できない問題を改修しました。
- 以下のドライバーで、接続機器との接続が復旧しない問題を改修しました。

 - ◇ Modbus SIO マスター
 - ◇ Modbus TCP マスター

8.3.13 GP-4100 シリーズ

- ハードウェア設定画面の[Date/Time]に表示される「年」が上下ボタンで変更できない問題を改修しました。
- 三菱電気株式会社 FX シリーズ CPU 直結を RS422/485(4wire)で使用すると、正しく通信しない問題を改修しました。

8.3.14 ST6000 シリーズ

- システムエラーSYS02002が表示された場合、バッテリー交換後に表示器を再起動してもシステムエラーが表示される問題を改修しました。

8.3.15 IPC シリーズ、PC/AT

- Windows の OS 言語が、一般ユーザーのグループ名が **Users** ではない環境（例：フランス語 OS）でランタイムが正しく動作しない問題を改修しました。

8.4 パフォーマンスの改善

- 画面編集ソフトウェアがプロジェクトファイルを転送する際のパフォーマンスを改善しました。
- 画面編集ソフトウェアがプロジェクトファイルを開く際のパフォーマンスを改善しました。

9 制限事項

この章では、画面編集ソフトウェア、ランタイムにおける制限事項を説明しています。

9.1 ライセンスの制限事項

- **Schneider Electric License Manager** でバージョン 3.0 のトライアルライセンスが有効な場合は、削除してください。
- トライアルライセンスの有効期限が切れたランタイムを起動した場合、**Schneider Electric License Manager** が起動し、ライセンスの入力を求められます。ランタイムを操作する前に **Schneider Electric License Manager** を閉じると、ランタイムを継続して操作できます。

9.2 作画時の制限事項

9.2.1 画面編集ソフトウェア

- 配列変数要素の変数を完全な変数名で検索することはできません。配列変数名または要素の変数名で検索します。
たとえば、検索対象が「**Var1 [Var2.Value].Value**」の場合、「**Var1.Value**」（配列変数名）または「**Var2.Value**」（要素で使用される変数名）で検索します。「**Var1 [Var2.Value].Value**」で検索することはできません。
- 20000 個以上の変数を使用しているプロジェクトファイルを画面編集ソフトウェアで開いている場合、変数編集画面で複数のフィルターを設定していると編集画面を切り替えた際にマウスカーソルの表示がビジー状態になる場合があります。再度切り替えを実行するとマウスカーソルが正常に戻ります。
- コンマ(,)は小数点の区切り文字として使用できません。
- **SoMachine** または **EcoStuxure Machine Expert** がインストールされている PC に、画面編集ソフトウェアをインストールすると、一部の USB ドライバーが認識されなくなる場合があります。
- 画面編集ソフトウェアで、読み取り専用のフォルダー内にあるプロジェクトファイルを開いた場合、書き込み可能なフォルダーに対してプロジェクトファイルを保存しようすると、画面編集ソフトウェアが強制終了する場合があります。
- 画面編集ソフトウェアのインストール先に **Unicode** 文字を含むパスを指定しないでください。インストールできません。**Unicode** 文字を含まないパスを指定してください。
- 画面編集ソフトウェアで、プロジェクトファイルを閉じた後に再度開いた場合、タブの状態が変わることがあります。
 - ひとつのドッキング領域に複数のタブがある場合、その順序が保持されません。
 - レイアウト要素（参照項目など）を閉じた後に再度プロジェクトを開くと、そのレイアウト要素が開いた状態になります。

- Windows 8.1 および Windows Server 2012 R2 は、画面編集ソフトウェアに対応していない OS です。画面編集ソフトウェアをインストールすることは可能ですが、正常に起動することはできません。
- 画面編集ソフトウェアで、ナビゲーションスイッチのプロパティにエラーがある場合、エラーウィンドウに表示されたメッセージからエラー箇所へ移動することができない場合があります。エラーウィンドウで[ソース]、[パス]、[プロパティ]の内容を確認し、手動でエラー箇所へ移動してください。

- 本バージョンで下記プロジェクトファイルを開く前に、リンク先を参照ください。マニュアルのトップページから[機能ガイド]のアイコンをクリックし、表示されたマニュアルの目次から[ご使用の前に] - [プロジェクトファイル変換の注意点]の順に選択します。

9.2.3 画面 / コンテンツ

- [画面の種類]で[ビューボックス]を選択した画面を追加した場合で、以下の条件に該当すると、表示器上で画面が正しく描画されない場合があります。
 - ▶ スクリプトで、以下のいずれかを実行している
 - ◇ 表示器のソースプロパティ(<表示器名>.Preferences.LanguageID)を使用して言語切替を実行
 - ◇ [セキュリティ]オペレーションの[ログイン]を実行
 - ◇ コンテンツ表示器のソースプロパティ(<オブジェクト名>.Visibility)を使用して可視状態を変更
 - ▶ 上記を実行したあと、画面切替またはコンテンツ切替を実行している
- 画面編集ソフトウェアで、コンテンツの幅および高さに大きな値を設定し、拡大率を変更した場合、正しくスクロールできない場合があります。スクロール操作を実施する前に、画面領域をクリックするとスクロールできるようになります。

9.2.4 部品 / 図形

9.2.4.1 コンテンツ表示器

- コンテンツ表示器および参照先コンテンツの幅・高さの値を、他のプロパティやスクリプトから参照しても、値が正しく取得できない場合があります。

9.2.5 フォント

- フォントの種類に含まれる、**Chinese_Simplified_GB2312_Gothic** は将来のバージョンにて使用できなくなる予定です。
このフォントを使用した古いバージョンのプロジェクトファイルを本バージョンで開くと、**Chinese_Simplified_GB18030_Gothic** に変換されます。

9.2.6 スクリプト

- スクリプト編集画面のテキストモードで検索と置換を使用する場合、特殊文字（'\$'、'^'、'*'など）を含む検索が正しく動作しないことがあります。
- スクリプト編集画面がテキストモードの場合、[参照項目]ウィンドウからテキストモードのスクリプトを置換することはできません。スクリプト編集画面の検索と置換を使用してください。

9.2.7 トリガー / オペレーション

- スクリプト上で、動作対象外のオブジェクトをタッチトリガーに指定しても、画面編集ソフトウェア上でエラーになりません。
 - アラーム表示器
 - ハードウェア設定
 - レシピデータ表示器
 - 画像表示器
 - ウェブブラウザ
 - 全てのレイアウトオブジェクト
 - 画面 / コンテンツ
 - グループオブジェクト
- [アラームグループ]オペレーションはシステムエラーには対応していません。画面編集ソフトウェア上では[アラームグループ]オペレーションで[SystemErrorGroup]を選択できますが、選択しても表示器上では動作しません。
- [SystemErrorGroup]のプロパティは現在サポートされていません。画面編集ソフトウェアで設定しても正しく動作しません。

9.2.8 アラーム

- スクリプトでアラームメッセージを変更できません。画面編集ソフトウェアでアラームメッセージを変更するスクリプトを作成するとエラーが発生します。

9.2.9 コンバーター

- 範囲コンバータで、[データの種類 (出力)]に[言語テーブル]を選択した場合に、文字ではなく文字列 ID が出力されます。

9.2.10 変数

- “Structure”という名前の変数を含む変数ファイルをインポートしないでください。
- 64 ビット長の変数と定数を比較演算子(<=, <, >, >=)で比較しないでください。表示器が動作しなくなります。定数の代わりに内部変数を使用してください。
- 画面編集ソフトウェアで、ポルトガル語、フランス語、スペイン語、イタリア語またはドイツ語を使用している場合、REAL または LREAL 型の変数の小数点区切り文字が異なる場合があります。プロパティ画面上ではコンマが使用され、変数編集画面上ではドットが使用されます。

9.2.10.1 シンボルリンク

- シンボルファイルをインポートした後、ドライバーを削除して再度追加しないでください。ドライバーを削除して再追加する必要がある場合は、ドライバーを削除する前にシンボルファイルを削除してください。
- シンボルファイルをインポートする場合、以下の制限事項があります。

未対応データタイプ

- ENUM
- INTERFACE

指定された既存データタイプに変換されるデータタイプ

- SUBRANGE
- POINTER TO
- REFERENCE

構造体データタイプに変換されるデータタイプ

- UNION
- FUNCTION_BLOCK

- Rockwell L5K ファイルの NamedBasic タイプの変数は、シンボルリンクで文字列変数として取り込まれます。

-
- IEC フォーマットに準拠しない **Unity-Pro** ファイルのアドレスがシンボルリンクにて取り込まれます。これらの変数のアドレスは空欄状態になっているので、削除してください。
 - **%IWS** と **%QWS** は **SoMachine Basic File only Modbus (.SMBP)**から取り込むことができません。
 - **TIA** シンボルファイルをインポートした後、シンボルファイルが入っているフォルダーの名前を変更しないでください。フォルダー名を変更する場合は、先にプロジェクトと画面編集ソフトウェアを閉じてください。
 - **Array** または **Structure** の **Pre-defined** タグを含む **L5K** のシンボルファイルを、シンボルリンクでインポートしないでください。

9.3 転送時の制限事項

- プロジェクトファイルを転送中に**[ALT]**キーを押すと、転送に失敗する場合があります。
- 多くの画像ファイルを含むプロジェクトファイルを表示器に転送した場合、転送に時間を要する場合があります。
- 大きいサイズのプロジェクトファイルを転送した場合に、転送完了後、表示器が起動しない場合があります。表示器をリカバリーモードで起動し、再度転送し直してください。

9.3.1 ST6000 シリーズ、STM6000 Series

- ローカルストレージを保持するか削除するかの確認ダイアログボックスに[キャンセル]ボタンが表示されますが、クリックしても何も動作しません。

9.3.2 IPC シリーズ、PC/AT

- バージョン 3.1 以前のランタイムをご使用の場合、バージョン 3.1 Service Pack1 以降のプロジェクトファイルを転送することはできません。転送しようとする、画面編集ソフトウェア上で以下のエラーメッセージが表示されます。

[ダウンロード操作では更新はできません。インストーラーを使用して、ランタイムを最新バージョンに更新してください。]

転送するには、最新バージョンのランタイムをインストールする必要があります。

インストーラーDVD の以下のパスから、ランタイムのインストールを開始できます。

"¥BLUE_Setup¥BLUERuntime¥BLUERuntime.exe"

最新バージョンのランタイムをインストールすると、インストール前に転送されていたプロジェクトファイルが消去されます。インストール後にプロジェクトファイルを再度転送してください。

.NET Framework がまだインストールされていない場合、またはそのバージョンが古い場合、.NET Framework もインストールされます。.NET Framework のインストール後、インストール先が再起動されます。

最新バージョンのランタイムをインストールするために、既にインストールされているランタイムをアンインストールする必要はありません。

9.4 表示器使用時の制限事項

9.4.1 画面 / コンテンツ

- スクロールグリッドコンテンツのサイズが表示先のコンテンツ表示器のサイズより小さい場合、スクロールグリッドコンテンツのサイズはコンテンツ表示器のサイズに拡張されます。
- システムエラーが頻繁に発生する等、間断なくバックアップメモリーへのアクセスが発生している状態で、多くの変数で値の変化が発生している場合、値の変化が正しく画面描画へ反映されない場合があります。
- 表示器と接続機器の通信が不安定な場合、画面切り替え時に表示器の画面が数秒間フリーズする場合があります。
- ズームキャンバスを使用した画面およびコンテンツを大きな倍率で表示している場合に、表示器およびシミュレーションで正しくスクロールできない場合があります。

9.4.2 ハードウェア設定画面

- ハードウェア設定画面上の操作によりランタイムが再起動した時、外部ストレージの認識状態が更新されない場合があります。この場合は、表示器の電源を再投入してください。

- ハードウェア設定画面内の操作ログ画面でフィルター設定画面[Filter Simplified]からフィルターを実行した場合、項目が正しく表示されない場合があります。
- Pro-face Connect の初回設定時、ハードウェア設定画面で設定を変更した後に[Save & Restart]をタッチしてから、表示器の電源を再投入して再起動してください。
- ハードウェア設定画面では、ドライバーごとに最大 32 台の機器の Scan Off Control が表示されます。ハードウェア設定画面から Scan Off Control を変更できない場合は、機器のソースプロパティ '.ScanOffControl'を使用して Scan Off Control を変更してください。

9.4.3 キーパッド

- キーパッド表示中に高速でタッチを繰り返した場合、押下時の反転表示が表示されない場合があります。
これは表示だけの問題で、値の書き込みは正常に行われます。

9.4.4 部品 / 図形

- オブジェクトの幅および高さが 600 以下の場合でも、表示器およびシミュレーションで影が表示されない場合があります。

9.4.4.1 テキストボックス

- テキストボックスオブジェクトで太字属性を使用すると、画面編集ソフトウェアと表示器で表示される文字の太さが異なる場合があります。

9.4.4.2 アラーム表示器

- アラーム表示器のフィルター設定画面[Filter Simplified]に表示できる項目は 146 個までです。146 個以上の項目がある場合は、[Search]にテキストを入力して絞り込むか、フィルター詳細設定画面[Filter Detailed]を使用してください。
- アラーム表示器のフィルター設定画面[Filter Simplified]でフィルターを実行した場合、項目が正しく表示されない場合があります。

9.4.4.3 数値表示器

- 数値表示器の[現在値]に、コンバーターと一緒にソースプロパティを設定している場合、数値表示器の[フォーマット]および[小数点桁数]プロパティが設定可能にもかかわらず、設定内容が適用されません。これらのプロパティの代わりに、コンバーターのプロパティで設定された内容が適用されます。対象のコンバーターは以下になります。

- 単位
- スケール
- 定義式

上記は正しい動作であり、将来のバージョンアップにより、数値表示器の[フォーマット]および[小数点桁数]プロパティは、上記の場合では表示が無効になります。

- [Arabic_Gothic]または[Hebrew_Gothic]フォントで接頭辞や接尾辞を設定すると、表示器上の数値表示器で文字の順序が間違っ表示されます。

9.4.4.4 文字列表示器

- IME で日本語入力する文字列表示器で[テキストを*として表示]を有効にしないでください。文字を入力する際に、現在格納されている文字列が表示されます。[テキストを*として表示]プロパティを使用する場合は、入力を開始する前に文字列をクリアするようにシステムを設計してください。

9.4.4.5 ウェブブラウザ

- ウェブブラウザ部品で TIFF および MNG 画像ファイルが非対応となりました。

9.4.5 トリガー / オペレーション

- タッチ中のオブジェクトが、他のオブジェクトのアニメーションや、可視の変化によって隠された場合、タッチトリガー(Click または Release)はそのタイミングでは発生しません。トリガーはタッチ中オブジェクトが隠されていないものと認識して動作します。
- [All]がチェックされている[配列]オペレーションの数が多いほど、初回の画面切替時間が遅くなります。
- [ファイル管理]オペレーションを使用する場合、ファイルまたはフォルダー名の文字が英語でない場合は[ファイル管理]オペレーションで表示されるダイアログ上でファイルまたはフォルダー名が正しく表示されません。
- 外部ストレージが表示器に認識されていない状態で[外部ストレージ]オペレーションが実行された場合に、システムエラーが発生しません。

9.4.6 ロギング

- [ファイル管理]オペレーションの実行中は、ログの周期によってはデータがログされない場合があります。
- トレンドグラフの表示点数、ロギンググループの最大レコード数、および使用している表示器の組み合わせによっては、トレンドグラフの表示が非常に遅くなる場合があります。トレンドグラフの表示点数は下記設定で増減します。

9.4.7 レシピ

- レシピデータの[最小入力]、[最大入力]を画面編集ソフトウェアで設定している場合、表示器で上でレシピデータの値を変更する時には[最小入力]、[最大入力]の値は表示されません。

9.4.8 ネットワーク

- 運転中、ローカルネットワーク上に存在する他の機器と重複する IP アドレスを設定しようとする場合や、表示器と重複する IP アドレスを持つ機器をローカルネットワークに接続した場合、IP アドレスの重複を検出できません。
ランタイム起動時のみ、ローカルネットワーク上に存在する機器の IP アドレスをチェックし、表示器と重複があればシステムエラーを発報します。
表示器の IP アドレス変更後はランタイムが再起動されますので、再起動後にシステムエラーが発報されていないか確認してください。

9.4.9 Web Viewer

- プロジェクトの転送が失敗した場合、Web Viewer ライセンスは削除されます。同じライセンスキーコードを使用して、表示器で Web Viewer を再度追加してください。

9.4.10 OPC UA サーバー

- OPC UA サーバー機能を使用している場合、表示器は初回起動時にサーバー証明書を生成します。また、OPC UA クライアントは初回の接続時にサーバー証明書を確認します。
以下の場合、サーバー証明書が更新されるため、OPC UA クライアントによるサーバー証明書の確認が再度必要になる場合があります。
 - ▶ ハードウェア設定画面にある OPC UA サーバーのメニューから証明書の再発行 (Regenerate Certificate)を行った場合
 - ▶ ファイルシステムによる転送を行った場合（イーサネットまたは USB ケーブルによる転送の場合、この問題は発生しません）

9.4.11 ドライバー

- Schneider Electric の Modbus タイプのドライバを使用している場合に、TM デバイスを含むシンボルファイルをインポートすると、それらのシンボルもインポートされます。ただし TM デバイスは未サポートのため、動作しません。

9.4.12 SP5000X シリーズ、SP5000 シリーズパワーボックス / オープンボックス

- CANopen Slave ドライバーと TIA Portal Ethernet ドライバーを同時使用する場合、他のドライバーを同時に使用しないでください。CANopen Slave ドライバーの通信が止まる恐れがあります。

9.4.13 GP-4100 シリーズ

9.4.13.1 CoDeSys Automation Alliance - CoDeSys V2 Ethernet / Schneider Electric – PacDrive

- GP4100 シリーズと以下のドライバーを使用すると、接続に関するシステムエラーが発生することがあります。
 - CoDeSys Automation Alliance - CoDeSys V2 Ethernet
 - Schneider Electric - PacDrive

9.4.14 ST6000 シリーズ

- フロー制御で XON/XOFF が動作しません。

9.4.15 IPC シリーズ、PC/AT

- ログイン、操作ログ、アラームのエクスポート先として、マルチバイト文字を含むフォルダ名またはファイル名を使用する場合、表示器の OS でシステムロケールを適切に設定する必要があります。
- 画像表示器の[保存先フォルダー]および画像のファイル名にマルチバイト文字を含む場合、表示器の OS でシステムロケールを適切に設定する必要があります。
- ランタイムをインストール後に初めて起動する場合は、スタートメニューから[BLUE Runtime]のアイコンを右クリックして表示されるメニューから[管理者として実行]を選択してください。管理者として実行しない場合、Welcome Screen が表示されない場合があります。
- ランタイムのインストール先に Unicode 文字を含むパスを指定しないでください。インストールできません。Unicode 文字を含まないパスを指定してください。

9.4.16 外部ストレージ(SD カード / USB ストレージ)

- 間断なく USB ストレージへのアクセスが発生している状態で、USB 取り出しを実行しても動作しない場合があります。
USB ストレージへのアクセスを中断する機能を設けるか、アクセス先のストレージを変更するなどの対応を行ってください。

9.5 サイバーセキュリティ

- 信頼できるプロジェクトファイルのみ画面編集ソフトウェアで開いてください。

- BLUE Runtime は、潜在的なサイバーセキュリティの脆弱性を持つ可能性のある古い Schneider Electric License Manager コンポーネントを使用しています。

Preamble

When we speak of free software, we are referring to freedom of use, not price.
